Section 3-2-1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Countryside shall be followed:

Any sale by any person who engages in the selling of clothing, toys, sports equipment, furniture, fixtures, appliances, tools, automobile parts & equipment, or any other personal property of any nature whatsoever, when such sale is held in a garage, basement, home or any place whatsoever, on any lot, tract or parcel of land which is located within any residentially zoned district as established by the zoning ordinance of the city.

Such application shall be submitted to the City Clerk's Office.

Other stipulations to keep in mind are:

- *A garage sale permit is required. (No fee involved)**
- *Limited to two (2) sales per year.**
- *Garage sale limited to two (2) consecutive days during any week.**

GARAGE/ESTATE SALES REQUIREMENTS

(City of Countryside Code 3-2-1)

Special Requirements:

- Permit Required: It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in a "garage sale" as defined herein without first obtaining a permit therefore from the city clerk.
- Limitation on Garage Sales: It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in such a garage sale from any street address more than two (2) times in any one calendar year. Such sale shall not extend for more than two (2) consecutive days during any week.

Fee: None **Garage Sale-Definition:** Any sale by any person who engages in the selling of clothing, toys, sports equipment, furniture, fixtures, appliances, tools, automobile parts and equipment, or any other personal property of any nature whatsoever, when such sale is held in a garage, basement, home or any place whatsoever, on any lot, tract or parcel of land which is located within any residentially zoned district as established by the zoning ordinance of the city.

SIGNS ALLOWED FOR GARAGE SALES

(City of Countryside Code 8-5-7 & 8-5-8)

Temporary Signs erected in connection with a rummage sale or garage sales are permitted in residential districts subject to the following:

- Only one sign not exceeding six (6) square feet in area, and
- No such sign shall continue to be used for more than three (3) days, and
- Such signs shall not be illuminated, and
- Off premises signs are prohibited– The sign must be on the premises where the sale is being held.
