- K. A person who is not a law enforcing public official, Mayor, Alderman, or member of the City Council of the City of Countryside;
- L. A person who has not been convicted two or more times of a gambling offense as proscribed by Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 38, Section 29-1, (a) (3) through (a) (10);
- M. Not a person who fails to present proof of dramshop insurance as required by Ord. 90-41-O.
