INFORMATIONAL ALERT

As Spring approaches so does the potential for criminal activity in area neighborhoods. The Countryside Police Department would like to remind you that door-to-door sales and solicitation is not permitted by the City of Countryside without a permit. Persons with permission to solicit in your area will be wearing bright yellow name tags with the City logo to identify them as permitted solicitors.

Remember, persons attempting to offer services, such as, tree trimming, driveway seal coating , roofing, and/or general house maintenance should be turned away. Also be aware of contractors who claim to be City employees, especially those claiming to work for the Water or Building Department. ALL City Employees are clearly identified by photo identification. DO NOT let unknown people into your residence and verify any questionable persons claiming to be City employees by contacting the City of Countryside directly.

Please report ANY suspicious people or circumstances to the Countryside Police Department as soon as possible by dialing 9-1-1.
