THE JUVENILE EXPUNGEMENT HELP DESK

will help you erase your record!

MARIJUANA MISDEMEANOR



The Juvenile Expungement Help Desk provides information and assistance to help you expunge (erase) your juvenile arrests and findings of delinquency from law enforcement and court records. To expunge your record, you must be 18 or older and have no open juvenile cases (including probation).

WHEN:

Mondays and Tuesdays: 9:00am – 4:00pm
Thursdays: 9:00 am – 12:00pm

BRING:

- If you already have a copy of your juvenile arrest record (“rap sheet”), bring it with you to the help desk.
- If you do not already have your rap sheet, **you may obtain a copy at the help desk for free.** Bring a photo ID. You may be fingerprinted if you have been arrested by any police department other than Chicago.
- If you were arrested after your 17th birthday, obtain your adult rap sheet for \$16 at 3510 S. Michigan and visit the CGLA help desk in Daley Center room 1006.

*Fee waivers are available, and we will help you fill them out! Without a fee waiver, there is a \$64 filing fee per petition (one petition per arrest) and a one-time \$60 expungement fee. Call LAF at 312-229-6359 with questions or for assistance.
