CRIME ALERT

The Countryside Police Department has been alerted to the following criminal activity in our area:

We have seen an increasing number of commercial burglaries to car dealerships during overnight hours in our area. This weekend, burglary suspects targeted a Countryside auto dealership, gained entry to the facility, but were unable to remove any vehicles.

In this, and other cases, multiple offenders make entry into the dealerships, generally through the service entrance, locate vehicle keys, and take multiple vehicles from the service area.

While conducting day-to-day business, please be aware of persons who appear to be casing your business or asking strange questions. You should also make every attempt to secure the keys to vehicles in the service area, on the sales floor, and in your lot. Lastly, be sure doors are secured, and alarms and video cameras are functioning properly.

The Countryside Police Department makes every attempt to patrol and monitor your business on a regular basis in the overnight hours.

Remember, any suspicious activity should be reported to the Countryside Police Department by dialing 9-1-1.
