The Countryside Police Department has been alerted to the following criminal activity in our area:

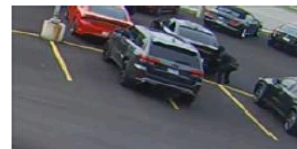
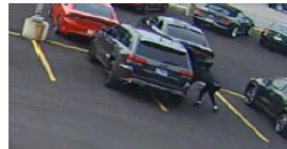
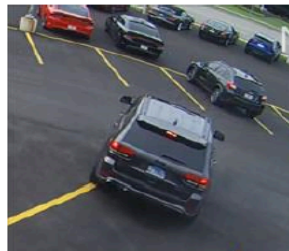

Offenders then flee the area with the stolen vehicle(s).

On Thursday, 05-27-2021, at approximately 0800hrs, the above pictured dark gray Jeep Grand Cherokee SRT, partial Illinois Registration# CJ2****, arrived at Autobarn Subaru, 6191 Joliet Rd, and parked behind 2 Dodge Charger SRT's. The complainant provided Illinois plate# CJ2087, no record on file. Both vehicles were just brought out shortly before from the service garage. Offender #1 exited the Jeep and made his way to the black Charger and was able to pry the rear driver side window down, after getting the window down, offender #2 got out of the Jeep and got into the black Charger. Offender # 1 then makes his way to the Red Charger parked next to the black one and begins to pry that window down when an employee notices them and drives his vehicle toward them. The Jeep then repositions as both offenders jump out of the black Charger and get back into the Jeep as the employee pulls up in attempts to box them in. The Jeep makes good on it's escape and is last seen southbound LaGrange Rd headed toward I-55. The Jeep did arrive from the west and most likely came from I-294. The two offenders match the description of the same two that struck Kelly Nissan in Oak Lawn on 05-24-21(case# 21-02461).
