The parade steps off at **1p.m. at 55th Place and Edgewood** and **proceeds two miles**—ending at Constance Lane and Joliet Road.

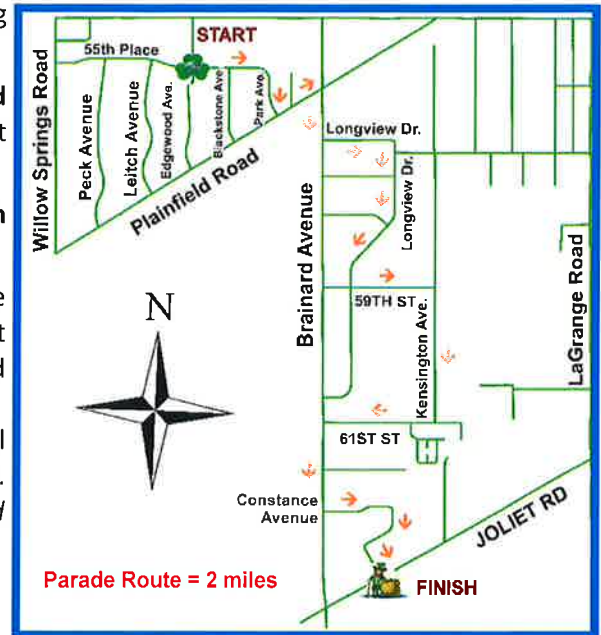
**All parade proceeds will benefit BEDS Plus and Interfaith Community Partners.**
