2-11-22	6:00 PM	5631 LaGrange Rd, Ettleson Hyundai	Forgery/Theft by Deception	In September of 2021 the offender used information from another person to complete a vehicle purchase purporting himself to be that person.
2-12-22	12:55 PM	6734 Joliet Rd, Countryside Bank	Forgery	The offender opened a business bank account in July of 2019. Over the course of several months the offender would deposit large business checks totaling over \$49,000 into this account while also making purchases on the account. The bank finally realized that the checks being deposited were fictitious and the account was in the negative by over \$16,000.
2-12-22	5:48 PM	5526 LaGrange Rd, Smoke and Talk Tobacco	Retail Theft	The offender ran out of the store with merchandise valued at over \$200 and fled in a 2003 silver Buick Lacrosse. The offender was described as M/B, approx. 30 yoa, with a tattoo on his right hand.
2-14-33	2:11 AM	55 Elm	Damage to Vehicle	The known offender damaged the mirrors on the victim's vehicle. When officers attempted to stop the offending vehicle, a white 2015 Chevrolet Impala, the driver fled.
2-14-22	5:33 PM	1516 W. 55 th St	Burglary to Motor Vehicle	Unknown offender(s) broke the rear passenger window of the victim's vehicle and removed a purse along with its contents.
2-15-22	11:36 AM	3 Countryside Plaza, Marry Me Jewelry	Credit Card Fraud	The offender completed a transaction over the phone using a stolen credit card number. The store owner became aware of the fact after the gold chain had already been sent to an address in Florida. This is an ongoing investigation.
2-14-22	2:00 PM	Countryside Plaza parking lot	Theft by Deception/Damage to Vehicle	The elderly victim was confronted by two offenders who initiated a "dent repair scam." This scam is where offenders prey on elderly victims in parking lots and offer to repair real or fictitious damage on the victim's car for a greatly inflated rate. The offenders then follow the victim to a bank or residence to redeem payment. In this instance the offenders followed the victim to Burbank and took over \$5,000 from his residence. The offenders are described as Males, olive complexion between 30-40 years of age. They were driving a silver Chevrolet Pick-up.
