5-20-22	12:00 PM	Countryside	Theft by Deception	The victim sent \$500 in an American Express gift card to the offender who purported themselves to be from Facebook as insurance for the delivery of a "Facebook Prize" which never existed.
6-10-22	8:05 AM	140 Countryside Plaza, Home Depot	Retail Theft	Two offenders removed \$2,898 worth of merchandise from the store without paying. Offenders described as: Suspect #1 - M/B, 6'0", black hat and sunglasses, gray t-shirt, blue jeans, black/white shoes, tattoos on upper left arm, and an earring in his left ear. Suspect #2 - M/B, 6'0", black shirt, red Adidas shorts with white stripes, chain necklace, short hair, wearing a surgical face mask.
6-13-22	7:16 AM	Joliet Rd at Willow Springs Rd	Hit and Run	A white box truck backed into the victim's vehicle at the light and then proceeded to flee the scene westbound Joliet Rd.
6-13-22	9:00 AM	140 Countryside Plaza, Home Depot	Theft/Unlawful Use of Credit Card	The offender rented an auger valued at over \$15,000 on 5-15-22 for a one day rental and never returned the item. The credit card used has been cancelled. Offender is described as a F/B in her 30's with a second subject driving the U-Haul truck which left southbound on LaGrange Rd.
6-13-22	10:00 AM	Countryside	Theft by Deception	An elderly victim was scammed for \$8,000 by the offender who convinced the victim that her Apple account was compromised. The victim purchased \$8,000 worth of gift cards and sent the codes to the offender. The offender attempted to exploit the victim further with a bank scam the following day until the victim's daughter was alerted to the activity. THE COMMON FACTOR IN ALL CASES SIMILAR TO THIS THEFT IS SUPPLYING GIFT CARD CODES TO AN INDIVIDUAL OVER THE PHONE.

6-15-22	7:31 PM	5500 LaGrange Rd	Aggravated Revoked D/L (Felony), Unlawful Use of Weapon	Cullen Falkman, M/44 yoa, Brookfield, IL	Officers stopped Falkman after the mobile ALPR alerted officers of a suspended registration. The investigation revealed Falkman had a revoked driver's license. Officers also recovered an electronic weapon (stun gun) in the vehicle which lead to the weapons charge. He was held for bond.
