9-9-22	12:19 PM	5555 Brainard, Marshalls	Disorderly Conduct	The offender yelled at the victim and struck her window with his hand following a dispute over a parking space. The offender fled the scene west on Plainfield Rd. Offender is described as a M/W in his 50's driving a black Audi.
9-9-22	7:04 PM	901 W. 55 th St, Citgo Gas	Retail Theft	2 offenders stole vape pens valued at over \$530 from the store. The offenders are described as a male and female black in their 30's driving an older model black Audi A class with no back plates.
9-10-22	6:29 PM	Birch Street	Theft of Bicycle	A black Bad Boy mountain bike was taken by an unknown offender after it was left outside unlocked.
9-12-22	8:44 AM	57 th and East Ave	Aggravated Assault	The offender pulled a pocket knife and threatened the victim after a minor traffic incident. The offender fled the scene west bound 55 th St in a white box truck.
9-14-22	12:45 PM	6001 S. LaGrange Rd, Starbucks	Forgery	Offenders passed three counterfeit \$20 bills for change and small purchases and fled the scene. Offenders described as three M/B's, mid 20's, one with a bandaged right arm and tattoos on his face. Starbucks was delayed in reporting this incident.
9-14-22	1:16 PM	5538 S. LaGrange Rd, Taco Taco	Forgery	The same offenders from the Starbucks incident attempted to pass more counterfeit \$20's. When the employee became suspicious, one offender pushed over the cash register prior to leaving. All three offenders entered a black 2008 Chevrolet Equinox and fled north on LaGrange. It was later discovered that they also committed similar incidents in Lyons shortly after and have been responsible for this type of activity in several other communities.
9-14-22	2:18 PM	6555 Willow Springs Rd, Barone's Pizza	Theft of Bike	The victim left his black mountain bike and went into the restaurant. While there, he observed the offender ride away on his bicycle east on Joliet Rd. The offender was described as a M/H, 20 to 30 yoa, 5'09", 160 lbs wearing glasses, a white short-sleeve button up shirt and cargo shorts.

9-15-22	2:37 PM	Countryside Plaza	Theft of Catalytic Converter	Unknown offender(s) stole the catalytic converter off of the victim's vehicle while it was parked in Countryside Plaza between 6:50am and 2:30pm.
9-15-22	7:54 PM – 8:49 PM	Countryside Area	Forgery	Officers took reports from four (4) different businesses about several different offenders passing or attempting to pass counterfeit bills. It appears to be the same vehicle used and at least some of the same offenders from the previous day's incidents at Taco Taco and Starbucks.
9-15-22	3:37 AM	5800 LaGrange Road, Countryside Mitsubishi	Attempted Theft of a Catalytic Converter	At 3:37am officers were dispatched to Countryside Mitsubishi for the security company reporting a male black wearing a black mask, black pants, white shoes, and an olive green hoodie walking through the parking lot looking at vehicles. While checking the area a black BMW sedan exited the parking lot of the Phelan Dodge dealership and fled north on LaGrange Road at an extremely high rate of speed. A vehicle with the catalytic converter partially cut off and hanging was found in the Mitsubishi parking lot. The BMW was later reported to have fled from police following a burglary in Melrose Park.
9-15-22	5:11 AM	5859 LaGrange Road, Jack Phelan Dodge	Burglary	An employee observed the offender, described as a M/B 25-28 years old, wearing a green/blue hoodie and blue jeans, standing inside the service area of the closed dealership. The offender was holding a hammer and screwdriver in his hands and told the employee to give him keys to one of the vehicles in the service area. The employee fled the area and called police. The building was checked, but the offender fled the area prior to the arrival of police. A broken window on a door was found to be the likely point of entry.
